## **SEXUAL BATTERY**

**DATE/TIME:** January 21, 2009 2:15 a.m.

**LOCATION:** 500 block Glenrock Ave.

**SUSPECT:** Male, White, short brown hair, 6', medium build, wearing white t-shirt and jeans.

On January 21 at 2:15 a.m. an unknown suspect stopped in front of the victim as she walked north bound on Glenrock. The suspect attempted to grab the victim's breast. The suspect grabbed the victim's wrist and pushed her against a wall. The victim was able to get away and ran down the street. The victim received a bruise to her head and scrapes to her hand, she did not require medical treatment.

- Do not walk alone at night. Walk in groups or with someone you trust
- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Walk in well lit areas

- Escort services are available on and around the campus between dusk and 1 a.m. by calling (310) 794-WALK. After 1 a.m. walk in groups or consider arranging other transportation.
- If you think you are being followed, do not go home, go to the nearest police or fire station, open gasoline station, or other well-lit place.
