At **approximately 12:47 a.m.**, a female UCLA student was walking in the **600 block of Hilgard Ave.**, when an unknown suspect grabbed her arm from behind. When the suspect wouldn't release the victim's arm, she punched the suspect in the face and the suspect released his grip and ran northbound on Hilgard Ave. toward Westholme Ave.

Suspect Description

#1: Male, Hispanic, 5'6"/130lbs, approximately 25 yrs, wearing a red and gray sweatshirt and blue jeans.

Weapon: Physical force

Suspect vehicle: No vehicle seen.

The UCLA Police Department would like to remind the community of the following safety tips:

Safety Tips

- **Stay alert and attuned to things around you, especially suspicious activities or people.**
- Do not walk alone at night. Escort service is available on and around the campus between dusk and 1 a.m. at (310) 794-**WALK**.
- If someone is loitering near your unoccupied car as you approach it, keep walking or go into a public place until the person leaves.
- If you think you are being followed, do not go home, drive to the nearest police or fire station, open gasoline station or other well lit place.
- If you are a victim of a crime, if possible, take mental notes of the suspect(s) physical description and mannerisms, this will aid in apprehending the suspect(s).
