**HATE CRIMES**

**2008** There was 1 hate vandalism on Campus-Student Housing characterized by race.

**2007** There were 2 aggravated assaults on public property characterized by race.

**2006** There were no reportable hate crimes.

**Sex Offense Notes:** Increased reporting from the resident halls most likely due to Violence Against Women grant where there has been an increased focus on education to incoming freshman as well as transfer students.

**On Campus Rapes (12):** A total of 5 victims reported a lapse in memory due to alcohol use during incident. A total of 8 victims were acquainted with the perpetrator. The other 4 on campus rapes, the relationship between the victim and suspect was not reported. No weapon was used in any of the on campus rapes.

**Alcohol Law Violations:** the Office of Residential Life conducted a more in depth review of their incidents and determined that they had over reported the number of alcohol violations based on incidents that were school policy violations only (e.g. possession of alcohol in bulk & party where alcohol is present) and often included those that were of age.
